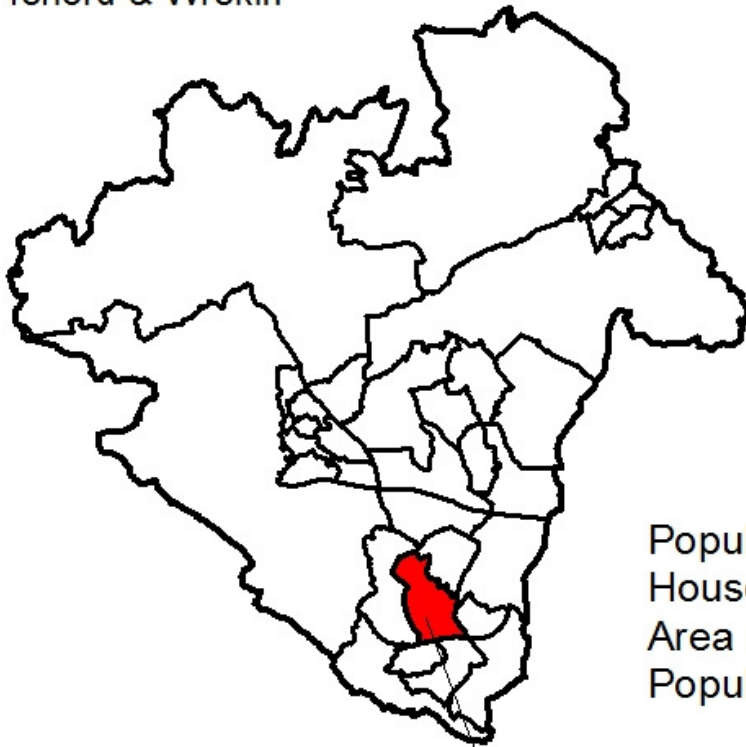
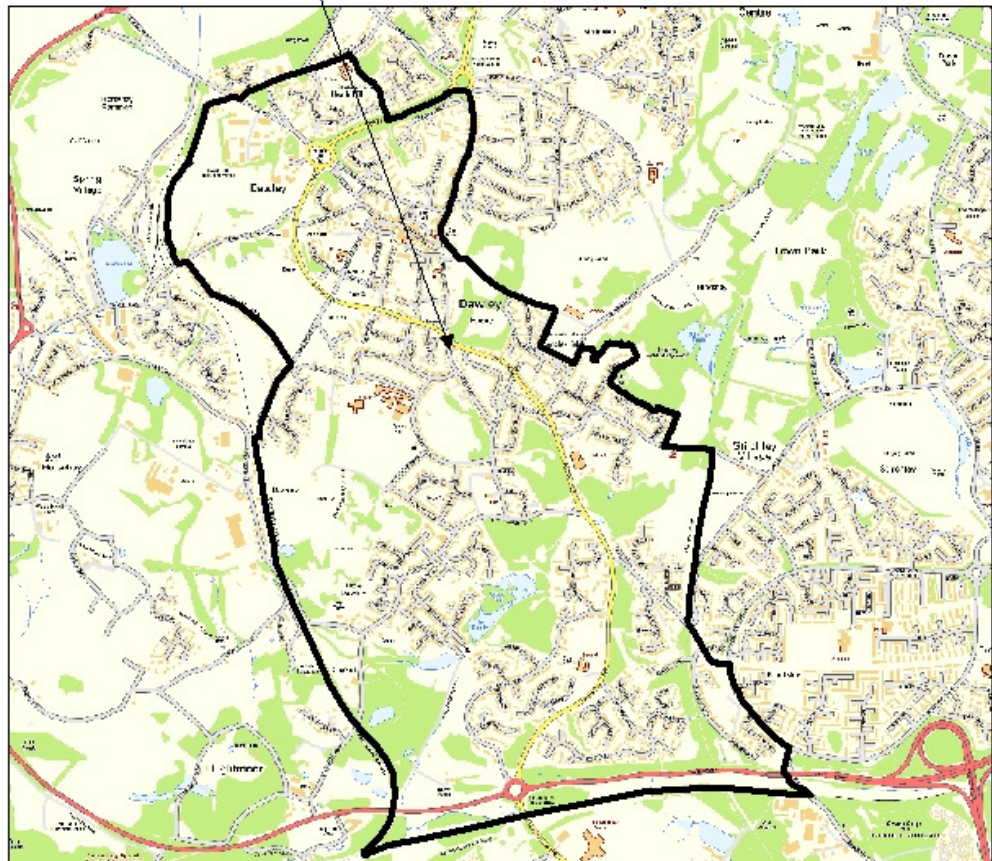

1 Population Characteristics

Summary:

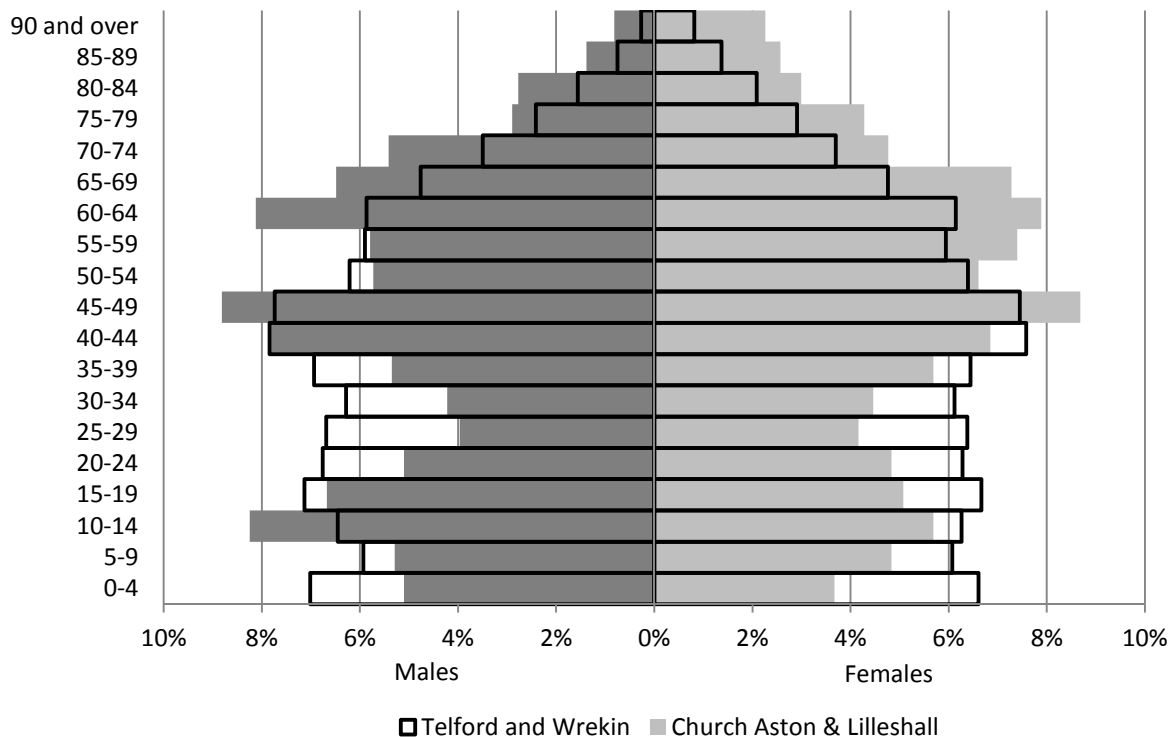
- Dawley Magna’s population decreased by 1.2% between 2001 and 2011.
- In the ten years prior to the 2011 Census, the 0-15 age group decreased by 15.4%, with those aged 16-24 increasing by 20.9%.
- The 25-44 cohort decreased by 16.8%, with the population aged 45 and over increasing; 45-64 doubled and 65+ increased by 15.4%.
- Dawley Magna’s population has large proportions of the 40-49 and 60-74 age groups, with higher proportions than Borough wide.

2 Diversity

Summary:

- The BME population of Dawley Magna grew by 37.8% between 2001 and 2011, accounting for 5.4% of the ward's total population, almost half the proportion seen Borough-wide (10.6%).
- The 'Other White' population has increased by 58.7% but representing just 2.1% is below the Borough rate of 3.2%.
- Though the proportion of Christians decreased from 73.7% to 60.7%, it still remained the largest religious group in the ward, but slightly lower than the Borough-wide figure (61.7%). The proportion of people with no religion nearly doubled.
- For the first time in a census, people were asked for their main language. Out of the 1.8% of the population whose main language is not English, the majority can speak English well or very well (1.4% of the population).

3 Household and family characteristics

Summary:

- The 2011 Census found 4,162 occupied household spaces in Dawley Magna accommodating 9,561 people.
- Nearly one third (29.8%) of households in Dawley Magna are one person households, higher than the Borough figure of 25.2%
- Some 22.7% of households do not have access to car, similar to the 23.0% seen in 2001. The average number of cars per household is 1.19 compared to 1.27 Borough wide.
- Some 61.7% of households in Dawley Magna were deprived in at least one dimension, higher proportion than the Borough (58.3%).

4 Housing

Summary:

- The number of household spaces in Dawley Magna has increased by 58 since 2001 accounting for just 1.8% of the 3,181 growth seen Borough wide.
- More than a third of households in Dawley Magna (37.1%) live in a semi-detached house or bungalow, higher than the Borough figure of 30.8%.
- More than a third of households in Dawley Magna (37.2%) own their home with a mortgage or loan, slightly higher than the 36.5% Borough wide. The number of households privately renting their home from a private landlord or agency has almost tripled since 2001.
- A total of 383 households in Dawley Magna (9.2%) mistakenly believe they rent their home from the Council.

5 Employment and economy

Summary:

- Between 2001 and 2011 the economically active population in Dawley Magna increased slightly from 69.9% to 71.7% and it is above the Borough rate (69.4%).
- Unemployment rate in the ward increased from 3.1% in 2001 to 5.0% in 2011.
- A total of 6.3% of Dawley Magna residents aged 16-74 have never worked, below the Borough rate of 7.2%.
- The proportion of people employed in 'elementary occupations' in Dawley Magna has fallen from 15.2% to 13.9% since 2001, but still slightly above the Borough rate.
- Almost a third of Household Reference Persons in Dawley Magna (32.8%) are classed as social grade DE - Semi-skilled and unskilled manual workers / On state benefit, unemployed, lowest grade, nearly double the Borough rate of 18.0%.
- The number of people in Dawley Magna who drive a car or van to work has increased since 2001, and now at 72.7% is higher than the Borough rate of 70.0%.
- Some 28.2% of Dawley Magna residents aged 16+ have no qualifications, higher than the 24.6% Borough wide.

6 Health and care

Summary:

- Some 7.4% of residents in Dawley Magna self reported bad or very bad health, higher than the 6.2% Borough wide.
- One fifth (20.2%) of residents felt their day-to-day activities are limited due to long-term health problem or disability, above the Borough (18.6%).
- Some 11.1% of residents provided unpaid care, slightly higher than the 10.8% Borough wide.

Notes and definitions

Household deprivation

The 2011 Census categorises households on their deprivation across four dimensions

- Employment – Any member of the household aged 16-74 who is not a full-time student is either unemployed or permanently sick
- Education – No member of the household aged 16 to pensionable age has at least 5 GCSEs (grade A-C) or equivalent AND no member of the household aged 16-18 is in full-time education
- Health and disability – Any member of the household has general health 'not good' in the year before census or has a limiting long term illness
- Housing – The household's accommodation is either overcrowded (occupancy indicator is -1 or less) OR is in a shared dwelling OR does not have sole use of bath/shower and toilet OR has no central heating.

Household Reference Persons

HRPs provide an individual person within a household to act as a reference point for producing further derived statistics and for characterising a whole household according to characteristics of the chosen reference person.

- For a person living alone, it follows that this person is the HRP.
- If a household contains only one family, then the HRP is the same as the Family Reference Person (FRP).
- If there is more than one family in a household, the HRP is chosen from among the FRPs using the same criteria used to choose the FRP i.e selected on the basis of their economic activity, in the priority order.
 - Economically active, employed, full-time, non-student
 - Economically active, employed, full-time student
 - Economically active, employed, part-time, non-student
 - Economically active, employed, part-time, student
 - Economically active, unemployed, non-student
 - Economically active, unemployed, student
 - Economically inactive, retired
 - Economically inactive, other
- If some are all FRPs have the same economic activity, the HRP is the eldest of the FRPs, if some or all are the same age, the HRP is the first of the FRPs from the order in which they were listed on the questionnaire.
- If a household is made up entirely of any combination of ungrouped individuals and other related families, the HRP is chosen from among all people in the household, using the same criteria used to choose between FRPs.
- Students at their non term-time address and short-term migrants cannot be HRP.

Dependent children

A dependent child is a person aged 0-15 in a household (whether or not in a family) or aged 16-18 in full-time education and living in a family with his or her parent(s). It does not include any children who have a spouse, partner or child living in the household.
